Spencer Levy, Chairman of Americas Research at CBRE appears on CNBC's Nightly Business Report with Diana Olick on January 4. He talks about reverse logistics, which is now the number one new user of warehouse space, occupying 700 million nationally. Reverse logistics is a term for the “hangover” of returns that come after the holidays and the processes by which they’re handled. The warehouse space provides an area for retailers to sort through the merchandise and make plans for the best way to manage the returns. Levy predicts the demand for warehouse space for reverse logistics will increase during 2019.
