gallery Carpenters Workshop. The property is steps from Rockefeller Center, Central Park and the Museum of Modern Art and features a newly designed lobby, common areas and elevators.

"693 Fifth Avenue is a true gem in the market," said Mr. Dubin. "After a targeted marketing campaign, the ownership's overall vision for the property came to fruition as we were able to secure leases with upscale tenants that complement the building's existing occupancy and create an overall identity as a hub for international fashion brands."

Currently at 264 West 40th Street, Bugatchi Uomo will relocate its New York City office to the eighth floor of the boutique office property. Stephane Abitbol represented Bugatchi Uomo in-house in the lease negotiations. Escada, which currently occupies retail space at 7 East 55th Street, will house its US offices on the sixth floor. The Cushman & Wakefield team of Jim McCaffrey and Ethan Silverstein represented the tenant.
