Since then, she has expanded her exploration in fabric and thread. Her photographs, paintings and fabric constructions have been exhibited nationally and internationally.

"Art can console by inviting the viewer to travel away into a place of beauty and joy," said Susan Byrnes. "My textiles seek to create a sense of warmth and comfort and provide a positive distraction for all to enjoy."
